Middle School Educator Position Description

This temporary leave position will be responsible for the CF2S education program at Coupeville Middle School. This position is responsible for garden-based instruction four days per week during the middle school advisory class and assisting in the High School Agriculture class for 1 hour on Tuesdays alongside the School Farm Manager. Responsibilities include prepping activities, supervising students, and maintaining the classroom space. The ability to work collaboratively with the Coupeville Farm to School team, classroom management, and time management are all essential to the position.

Overview of Responsibilities

- Prepare and implement planned lessons four days per week during middle school advisory class
- Leads students' hands-on experiences during advisory lessons
- Assist the Agricultural teacher and School Farm Manager once per week in the HS Ag classroom and garden
- Works under the supervision of the CF2S Staff and Board

Summer Camp Education Assistant Position Description

Pay: \$18-\$21/hr DOE

This temporary position will be responsible for assisting the CF2S Education Coordinator in elementary, middle, and high school summer camps. This position will cover three days per week over four weeks. Kindergarten through 2nd grade camp, 3rd grade through 5th grade camp, middle school camp, and high school camp. Responsibilities include prepping activities, supervising students in art, cooking, and hands-on gardening activities, and maintaining CF2S summer camp spaces. The ability to work collaboratively with the Coupeville Farm to School team, student behavior management, and time management are all essential to the position.

Qualifications

- Experience teaching elementary and/or middle school-aged students in informal or formal outdoor education, classroom, or other relevant context;
- Experience with lesson planning and implementation;
- Strong team player, collaborator, and leader;
- Well developed time management skills;
- Excellent communication skills orally and in writing, excellent listener;
- Self starter, self directed; and
- Reflective, sees self as a lifelong learner.

Summer Camp Assistant: Relevant childcare or educational experience
